We are looking for *highly motivated* high school golfers, as well as middle school students who wish to prepare to join their high school golf team. We will offer a **first-of-its-kind program** that targets high school golfers who wish to excel on their high school teams and play in Illinois Junior golf tournaments. We are also targeting 7th and 8th grade students who wish to be well prepared for high school golf.

Our reasons and goals:

1. Most other sports offer similar club teams (soccer, swimming, baseball, etc.). More and more, the best players are coming out of these club teams. This is because the members of club programs are all *motivated individuals, with good coaching*.

## *Performance Golf Schedule* (April, May and June 2007)

All lessons and practice for the spring session will take place at the Golf Club of Illinois. On your first day, please bring a check payable to Performance Golf Club for \$295.00 **This will cover all costs of the program:** one ½ hour private lesson per month with J. Anderson, supervised practice time, range balls during your practice time/lesson and a junior golf pass\* at the Golf Club of Illinois for the duration of the session that you are attending.

1. Prior to your first supervised practice time, you must schedule your ½ hour private lesson with J. Anderson. In addition, you will need to book your ½ hour private lesson at the end of each month.
2. On Tuesday or Wednesday, each week, you will be assigned a 1 hour, supervised, small-group practice time. If your family is taking a vacation, you will be responsible to work out a makeup date with J.
3. We encourage you to schedule time with other club members to utilize your youth membership and to practice what you have learned. Tee times must be arranged with the Golf Club of Illinois' pro shop\*.

If you would like additional one-on-one time with J., the following reduced lesson rates will apply: Juniors \$50.00/45 minutes.

\*J. Anderson, GCI golf professional and Performance Golf Instructor will determine eligibility of the player for this benefit. Available during the Spring, Summer and Fall sessions.
